She co-authored Jolly Music and has written many articles for publications such as Music Teacher.

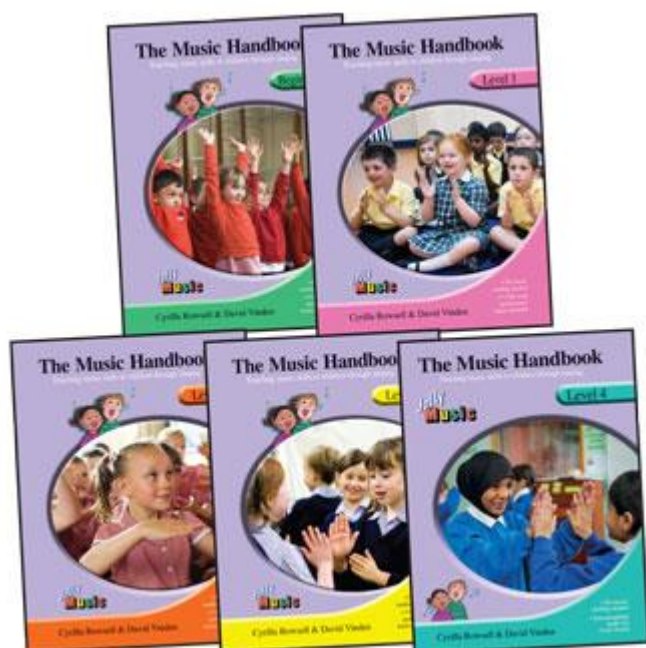
